Handicap yardage - Please be sure to have your card punched after every yardage earn. If you should have any doubt about the yardage punched on your card, please contact the A.T.A. office immediately.

Date of birth - Please notify the A.T.A. office of your birth date if you have not already done so. This will help in their efforts to identify and research records.

Classification - This portion of your average card will be filled out at the classification counter of larger shoots to show your singles and doubles class and your handicap yardage at that shoot. This portion is usually not filled out at shoots where you are furnished with a separate classification receipt.

Lines 1-5 include the previous two years' target totals and averages
 Line 1 = singles
 Line 2 = singles league
 Line 3 = handicap
 Line 4 = doubles
 Line 5 = doubles league

Lines 6-7 indicate
 A.T.A. number
 date card was issued

Lines 8-11 indicate shooter's name and address
 Line 12 indicates type of membership (life or annual) and expiration date for annual members

1. Date = date score shot
2. Place = name of gun club
3. SGLS = singles score
4. Average = singles average to date. This average is based upon current target-year scores only. There is no carryover from the previous target year. The most accurate way to figure your average is to total the number of targets broken and divide by the total number of targets shot at.
5. Class = This column is to list the singles class you were placed in at that particular shoot.
6. W/T = If you win or tie for your singles class that day you would put a "W" for win or "T" for tie in this column. If you win your category (i.e., veteran), do not enter it as a win or tie unless your score is as high or higher than the class winner.

7. HDCP = handicap score. This discipline is based upon yardage assignment and earned yardage, so there is no reason to keep a record of average on your card.
8. DBLS = doubles score
9. Average = doubles average to date. As in singles, the average is only for the current target year. Again the average is figured by dividing the targets shot at into the targets broken.
10. Class = This column is to list your doubles class for the shoot.
11. W/T = List your doubles wins (W) or ties (T) here. Again, this is for class wins, not category. However, if your score equals or is higher than the class winner, you must list it as a win or tie in this column.
