WELCOME TO THE NINETY-THIRD
ANNUAL LOUISIANA STATE TRAPSHOOT

The Louisiana Trapshooting Association is pleased to present this program for the 2017 Louisiana Trapshooting Championships.

1. This tournament will begin Friday, May 19, 2017.
 - a. Events 1 through 3 will be preliminary events (open trophies).
 - b. Events 4 through 6 will be the Louisiana Championships (Trophies for both State and Open winners)
2. Daily fees: ATA-\$3.00, LTA-\$3.00.
3. Program targets will be \$36.00 per 100 for all adults. For Juniors and Sub Juniors who do not play options, targets will cost \$25.00 per 100.
4. Practice targets will be \$5.00 per 25 for singles or handicap and \$5.00 per 12 pair of doubles.
5. You may use your own shells including reloads. All shells and reloads must meet A.T.A. specifications.
6. There are no compulsory purses.
7. Toby Bancroft Memorial Gun Club will be open Thursday, May 18th from 3:00 to 5:00 for pre-registration.
8. SQUADING will be accepted only with specific shooter names, ATA numbers, and payment.
9. RE-SQUADING — Once field assignments are posted for a particular event, re-squading will no longer be allowed.
10. PRE-SQUADING — Will be available on-line at PreSquad.com
11. Officials of the LTA will make all program interpretations.

SHOOT-OFFS

LTA will oversee and referee all shoot-offs. LTA decisions are final.

All Shooters that tie in the Preliminary Singles (Event II) and/or Preliminary Doubles (Event I) will carryover to Saturday's Singles (Event IV) and/or Sunday's Doubles (Event V). Winners determined by sub-events.

Contestants will be called, First Call, Second Call, and Final Call for shoot-offs. No response, shooters will forfeit.

All singles & handicap shoot-offs will be on a 25 target basis and doubles will be on 10 pairs.

ANNOUNCEMENT

This printed program will absolutely govern the Tournament. The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided herein. The Executive Committee reserves the right, in its sole discretion, at any time prior to, or during this Tournament to change or modify the program in any manner it deems necessary.

DISQUALIFICATION

Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.


