GENERAL INFORMATION

The Zone Meeting will be held Sunday, June 4th, between Events 3 and 4. Business will include selection of Central Zone NTA Directors.

Each zone singles, handicap, and doubles champion (or the runner-up as alternate) will be eligible to compete in the Nebraska State Shoot championship event for the Zone Champion of Champions award.

The highest single score in each class (excluding the Zone Singles Champion), from the Zone Shoot will constitute the Zone Team. The Zone Team with the highest score on the first 100 targets in the State Singles Championship event on Saturday will be declared the Zone Team Champion.

Central Zone Champions and Award Winners must live in the Central Zone. Open Awards, courtesy of Bradford Land Co. LLC are open to all shooters. A shooter may win only one award per event.

Management reserves the right to modify this program as weather, attendance or conditions warrant and reject, refund or disqualify any person who interferes with the conduct, accuracy or sportsmanship of the shoot. This shoot is sanctioned and governed by ATA rules.

This is an invitational tournament and the Directors of the NTA reserve the right to reject, refund or disqualify a contestant who, in their judgment, interferes with the conduct, accuracy or sportsmanship of the shoot. In the event of a dispute over any part of this program, the decision of the Directors shall govern. By entering the tournament, the contestants agree to abide by all rules of the ATA and the NTA and abide by all decisions of the Directors.

CLASSIFICATION

Penalty Class and Yardage will be required when a shooter has not met the minimum target requirements as set forth below.

Any shooter who has not shot the following number of Registered Targets in 2016 and/or 2017 prior to May 31, 2017 will be classified and handicapped as shown:

Total Target Minimums 2015-16 Class/Yardage Penalty

16 Yard
1000 Class B or more, Male shooter 18 yrs. & over
500 Class B or more, Male Junior shooter
500 Class B or more, Lady, Sub-JR, Veteran

Handicap
1000 22 or more, Male shooter 18 yrs. & over
500 22 or more, Male Junior shooter
500 21 or more, Lady, Sub-JR, Veteran

Doubles
250 Class B or more, Male shooter 18 yrs. & over
200 Class B or more, Male Junior shooter
100 Class B or more, Lady, Sub-JR, Veteran

Senior Veterans will not be required to shoot penalty yardage

SINGLES AND DOUBLES AVERAGES MUST BE CALCULATED ON CARD PRIOR TO SIGN-UP OR SHOOTER MAY BE REQUIRED TO SHOOT PENALTY CLASS A OR HIGHER.
