- Doubles classes
 - A (100 93), B (92.99 89), C (88.99 85), D (84.99 & under)
- Payoff sheets will be mailed with checks
- All purses and options are non-compulsory
- All targets shot by ATA members in these registered shoots will be reported to the ATA for inclusion in each shooter's records
- All participants registering ATA targets must be current ATA members
- All Wisconsin participants must be current WTA members
- All classifying will be done by the Handicap Committee
- Shooters with less than 500 targets in each discipline will be placed in Class 'B' for 16 Yard and Doubles and at the 20-yard line for Handicap
