## General Information

It is the responsibility of the shooter to be informed of the contents of this program and rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots. All shooters must be classified before making their entries. On Championship Singles, target fees for all resident Sub-Junior, Junior & Junior Gold will be reduced by 50% provided no monies are played. They will be eligible for added monies.

- Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.
- Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.
- Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities of any and all accidents at this shoot.
- The MTA president and State ATA delegate will act as a committee to rule on all disputes.

### **WHITE FLYER ORANGE TOP PITCH TARGETS WILL BE USED EXCLUSIVELY.**

Food service will be available from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

Program targets will be shot on 8 fields,

The practice field will be open at 4:00 P.M. Wednesday, July 25th and during the shoot. Practice rounds are \$6.00 per 25.

Campsites and RV parking is available. Reservations are \$20.00 per night on a first-come first-served basis. Sites include water but no power. For reservations, contact Bob Tellefsen at BT\_NetTC@Hotmail.com or 207-838-7833. Camper access is available on or after Saturday July 21st.

Trophies will be available for pick up each day and will not be mailed.

Cell phones and pagers are not permitted on the line at any time.

It is the shooter's responsibility to verify his scores on both the score sheets and the score board. Once purses and options are figured they will not be changed, but scores will be corrected for record purposes.

Starting fields will be drawn at random. All events will be shot 100 per field using the "Quick 50". Please take 50 rounds to the line.

Strict adherence to ATA rules regarding alcohol usage, eye protection and ear protection will be observed.

Ties in singles and doubles on Thursday and Friday will be carried over. Ties in handicap will be shot off.

The ATA rebate to the MTA for 2017 was \$864.

It is the responsibility of category shooters to declare their classified category and make sure it is indicated on their form

Saturday's singles classification will determine the All-Around class.

There will be a meeting of the MTA membership Sunday between events. All Maine resident shooters are encouraged to attend.

## Classification

Classification will be based on last 600 targets or total average whichever is higher. Average cards must be kept up to date or the shooter may be classified AA. It is the shooter's responsibility to declare category.

The Classification Committee will consist of the Maine ATA Delegate/Alternate Delegate, an officer of the MTA or appointee. Classification will be available Wednesday evening from 5:00 until 7:00

### Penalty

Shooters not having at least 600 singles, 500 handicap or 400 doubles for 2017 and 2018 combined will be penalized as follows:

Singles	Class B or Higher
Doubles	Class B or Higher
Handicap	Adult male shooters will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yardage subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies, sub-juniors, juniors, and veterans will follow the same rules except the minimum will be 21 yards. No penalty will be assigned to Senior Veterans. Category shooters may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempt from penalty yardage and compete for their special category trophies only
