The Medford Gun Club has been selected by the OSATA Directors in the Oregon Southern Zone to be the host of the First Oregon ATA Southern Zone Trapshooting Championships

The five highest scoring Southern Zone resident Singles shooters present at the State Shoot in Portland will represent the Oregon Southern Zone in the Zone Team Championship.

Shooters

The Medford Gun Club welcomes everyone to the first-ever Oregon ATA Southern Zone Trapshooting Championships. This is a 500 target, 2 day ATA competition. The club will be open at noon on Friday, May 11 for handicapping, squadding and practice.

Handicap events on Saturday and Sunday will be OSATA Magnum eligible. There is more than \$3000.00 in the magnums and they are open to all shooters. All trophies in this program are money with the exception of the five class HOA trophies which have been donated by Mike Mann.

All shooters whose current address is in Curry, Josephine, Jackson, Klamath, Coos, Douglas, Lane and Deschutes Counties are members of the Oregon ATA Southern Zone and will be competing in the Saturday Singles Championship for a spot on the Southern Zone Team.

The top five scorers in Saturday's Singles Championship who attend the 2018 State Shoot will represent the Oregon Southern Zone in the Zone Team Championship where they will compete against teams from the Oregon Northern and Eastern Zones. 2018 is the first year for the Zone Team competition at the State Shoot.

Cross registration to the PITA is supported and encouraged. PITA daily fee of \$4.00 and OSTA fee of one cent per target will be charged. Memberships must be current and, in the event that yardage is earned, both cards will be punched.

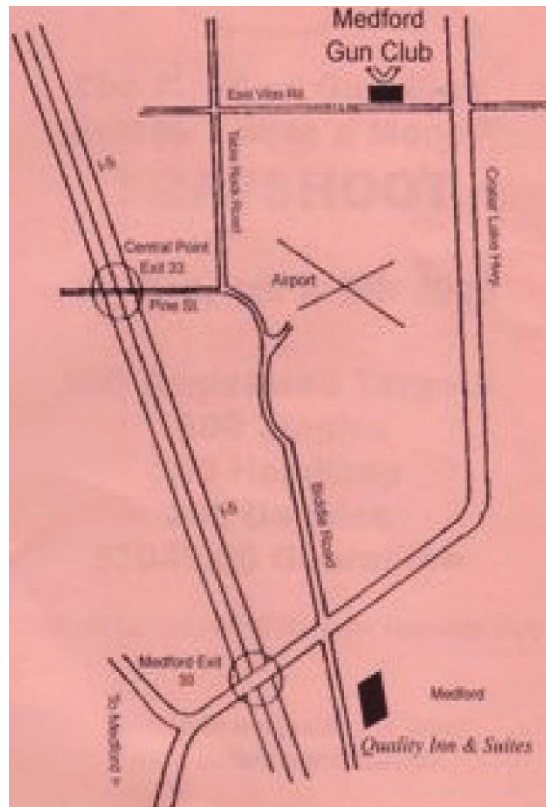
