

On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Colorado State Trapshooting Association, I want to welcome all shooters to the 2023 Colorado State Trap Shoot.




Weather may be fickle, but our trap friends are solid. Good luck. Have fun and break 'em all!

\*\*The criteria for election as a State Delegate or Alternate Delegate shall be actual physical residence within the boundaries of the State of Colorado, in receipt of life membership certificate from the A. T. A. and member in good standing of the Colorado State Trapshooting Association. A candidate for election must evidence membership in good standing for at least 5 consecutive years, active participation of at least 500 targets (Singles, Handicap and Doubles combined) in current and previous 4 years with at least 3,000 targets total in current and previous year. Target participation may be waived for shooters with an extensive target history who, because of documented physical problems, are not currently able to participate. A candidate must have not been suspended for any reason from the ATA.

NOTE: Only those CSTA Members with a CSTA 2023 membership card and in possession of a current paid average card issued by the ATA can vote. (If you plan on voting for your ATA Delegate and ATA Alternate Delegate, please renew your ATA membership prior to the State Shoot). CSTA members who qualify will be given a ballot at registration.

### **GENERAL SHOOT RULES**

- · Purses and options are not compulsory.
- Shooting starts promptly at the time indicated and only the starting squads will be called. Please watch the "ON DECK" signs.
- Classification will be based upon generally accepted ATA procedures and all decisions of the classification committee are final. Please have your average card up to date with your averages calculated.
- Squad Changes: There is a \$10.00 change fee for any squad changes made after 3:00 pm the
  previous day.
- Please attend the meeting for all Colorado Trap Shooters after the 1st 100 singles on Saturday, June 17, 2023 at Noon to elect the ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate. The Colorado State Team awards will also be presented.
- Please attend the 2023 Hall of Fame ceremony and induction during Friday Night, June 16th.
- ALL EVENTS WILL BE SHOT 5 TARGETS PER POST, 50 PER TRAP (Shoot management reserves the right to modify this format.)
- Ties for events A, C, 1 & 3 (Singles & Doubles) will be carried over to the next like event.
- Handicap ties will be determined by CSTA officials at the end of each day of shooting. If you do
  not report for shootoffs within the allotted time, you will forfeit. No exceptions to this rule. NO
  CARRY OVERS!
- The CSTA reserves the right to alter or modify the program and to reject anyone who, in our
  opinion is detrimental to the shoot.
- It is the responsibility of money winners to report their winning to the IRS. Provide your SSN to the
  cashier during registration to expedite any payoffs you may have coming.
- Board of Directors meeting: Friday June 16, 2023 6:30pm at PPGC Clubhouse
- Practice Traps will be open & available @ 7:30am daily. Practice rounds will be \$7.00 per 25 targets. Traps available will be posted near bank assignments along with announced. NOTE: During all CHAMPIONSHIP events practice fields will be limited to UPPER Fields up until first flight of shooters due to all 14 fields will be used during these events. PPGC Trap Committee will modify/designate practice fields for the betterment of the shoot at their discretion.
- Added money is open to all shooters entered in the event.
- Entrants for husband/wife (Domestic Partners) or two in a family (immediate family such as parent or siblings) in Event 5 must declare prior to the start of the event. You can win only one category.
- (1) It is the responsibility of all special category shooters to ensure they are placed in the correct category at the time they are classified/handicapped. If your special category does not appear on the bulletin sheet, report the omission at the cashier's.
- (2) Class Advance: High Score in each class in Events 1 & 3 will be advanced for all like events. Class advancements will apply independently to in-state and out-of-state classes. PAID OPTIONS FOLLOW SHOOTER TO ADVANCED CLASS.
- (3) 100 or 200 Straight Pins: Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight without carryover will be awarded a 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any one individual.
- (4) There will be no co-winners/champions. Ties must be settled for trophies purposes and All American Points.
- (5) Credit cards accepted with a 3% charge for all targets, options and purses (Visa, MasterCard, Amex, Discover)

### SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

- 1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
- 2. A female shooter, who had reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
- 3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th Birthday, may declare Sub-Junior.
- 4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th Birthday may declare as Junior.
- 5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd Birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
- 6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th Birthday may declare as a Sub-Veteran.
- 7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th Birthday may declare as a Veteran.
- 8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.
- 9. Age based categories are established on the Birthday of the shooter. For purposes of determining age category for HOA and HAA awards the category declared by the participant of the first day he/she shoots shall be used.
- 10. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example a shooter reaching age 70 may elect to continue to shoot as a Veteran for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year. Note: Age based special category shooters that are in contention for or desire to achieve All-American Team recognition should review the All-American Team policy in the ATA Rule Book. When there is no Sub-Junior trophy Sub-Juniors will be included in the Junior category. Senior Veterans will be included in the Veteran category when there is no Senior Veteran trophy.

**PETS:** Shooters are required to have their pets leashed at all times while on the grounds. It is also mandatory that you clean up after your pet. Owners will be held liable/responsible for their animals.

**ATVs AND GOLF CARTS:** Use of personal ATVs and golf carts is allowed. Owner must have liability insurance.



### Congratulations to Colorado State Trap Shooting Association's 2023 Hall of Fame Inductee.

#### Mike Herman

Mike started trap shooting in 1979 when his uncle, Dave Herman, ask him to go along to a trapshoot at Gillette Gun Club in Wyoming. Since he'd never shot trap before, he had to buy a "trap gun". His choice, an Ithaca Model 37 Featherweight pump shotgun. He didn't shoot a "Hall of Fame" caliber score, but the event hooked him for life or for at least the past 44 years or so.

It didn't take long and shotgun upgrades, reloaders, supplies and all the "stuff" a trap shooter needs started to accumulate. The crowd grew too. Mike's father, mother and sisters were all shooting in the 80s and beyond. This trend continues today. Mike's children, Shane, John and Nikki have all registered targets and are still shooting today. Mike's dad Richard and sister, Samantha Rainsdon, continue to be active as well.

Eventually with a lot of practice, the scores started to rise; trophies added up and Mike made the Wyoming State Team in 1983. He finished his Wyoming in-state career with two State Singles Championships, two State Handicap Championships along with a pile of other trophies.

In 1986, Mike joined the US Air Force. After basic training and carrier field training, Mike ended up in San Antonio, TX where he had a tryout for the Air Force Shooting Team. This began his International Trap & Skeet career that lasted until his retirement in 2009. He made his first US National Team in 1993 and remained on the team through 2008. He was fortunate to travel all over the world with a shotgun. Whether it's loosing baggage in Cyprus, winning his first World Medal, a bronze in double trap in Peru, or being arrested on a plane in London, Mike enjoyed every minute of his international career. He was fortunate enough to win a Gold, Silver & Bronze medals, was the alternate to the 2004 Olympic Team, made a Pan American Team, a World Championship Team and a Champion of Americas Team.

Mike took a hiatus from ATA shooting from 1987 through 1992 while learning how to shoot International Trap. When he came back, Dan Treat explained to him that not putting a shell in the gun was a "mulligan" or "Failure to Fire". My how things have changed. And don't ask Mike what he thinks of the "Failure to Fire" rule unless you have some time to hear the rant!

Over the years, Mike has won a Double Trap National Championship, World Cup Medals, State Championships and hundreds of other awards. He's made Colorado State Teams, has Colorado State Singles, State Doubles and HAA Championships to his credit.

One of his most memorable accomplishments in shooting was on May 27, 2007 at Pikes Peak Gun Club. He shot a perfect 300 and completed his Grand Slam on the same day. He's a current All American, has both the AA27AA and AAA27AAA ATA pins. He's been on the high average list a handful of times and was AAA27AAA in ATA and Master Class in sporting clays in the same year.

You can tell, he's spent a few days shooting. He also has been deeply involved in the club, state and national organizations for years. During his Colorado State President year, he was the President of Pikes Peak Gun club and the ATA Colorado Delegate. He was also blessed to be the 2020 ATA President. Or as he calls it, the COVID President. While taking tremendous pressure to cancel the 2020 ATA Shooting Year, he instead led an exceptional team that hosted the 2020 Grand American in Linn Greek, MO after the State of Illinois closed the World Recreation and Shooting Complex in Sparta, II.

This is just the brief highlights of a long shooting career. However, the most important benefits of shotgun shooting are the relationships. He met shooters from all over the world and even participated with a team of shooters from Colorado in the 2018 World Down the Line Championships in WAGGA WAGGA NSW Australia.

He couldn't have done any of this without the unwavering support of his family. His wife Jaimie has stood by Mike through it all, never complaining about taking care of the kids and home while Mike was traveling for work and shooting. She took all the pressure off allowing Mike to focus on shooting sports. Without her, none of this would have been possible. Jaimie, Shane, John & Nikki, thank you for putting up with a trap shooter!!


