2. Entries for the first event each day must be cashiered no later than 30 minutes after the event starts.
3. Targets may be cross-registered with PITA. PITA Daily Fees \$4, AZ \$3
4. Juniors and Sub Juniors will be offered \$30/100 entry fees courtesy of 2 Lazy 2 and the ASTA.

THE ASTA BOARD OF DIRECTORS



Tom H. Strunk

The ASTA Board of Directors are pleased to announce the 2023 inductee into the Arizona State Trapshooting Hall of Fame is Tom H. Strunk. Tom has been a member of both the Arizona and California State teams. He began his ATA membership in 1978 when he started competing. He shot 1,600 singles and carried an average of 96.38% and 1,600 handicap targets with an average of 91.63%. He shot only 100 doubles targets at an average of 75%. Five years later he carried a singles average of 98.77%, handicap average of 94.43% and a doubles average of 97.00%.

In 1985, Tom was ranked 3rd in the nation in the Trap & Field All-Around Average award. He was ranked 4th in the nation High Average Handicap Leader and 2nd in California. On September 15, 1985, he completed Grand Slam # 50. Also, in 1985 Tom became the second person in ATA history to run 100 singles, 100 handicap and 100 doubles. Yes, 300 by 300 on the same day! He was also the ATA Western Zone Handicap Champion with a 99 from the 27 yd line.

Later that year as Tom sat in his trophy vault polishing trophies, he decided to try his hand at sporting clays. He earned his way onto the United States team to compete in England at the English Open. In 1989, Tom was HOA out of state winner at the Arizona State Shoot with a with a 397x400.

In 2007, Tom became an Arizona resident and opened the Arizona chapter of his shooting career. His Arizona achievements are as extensive as are his California achievements and will be presented at the Hall of Fame ceremony. The Arizona Trapshooting Hall of Fame was established in 1985 and serves as a lasting legacy to the shooters of yesterday, today and tomorrow. Tom becomes the 59th Inductee into the AZ Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

In 1985, Tom Strunk, who won two trophies during 1989 California competition, became the second person in the ATA to run 100 in singles, handicap and doubles in the same day. That same year, he was ATA Western Zone handicap champion for 99 from 27. At the end of that year, Tom became interested in shooting sporting clays. He earned his way onto a United States team to compete in England at the English Open.

Tournament Rules

1. Arizona Residents must be current ASTA members at the time of classification/entry.
2. Daily Fees will be charged once per day per participant. ATA \$4.00 - ASTA \$3.00
3. ATA Rules govern all events. By entering an event, shooters agree to abide by all ATA Rules and Regulations and to accept all official decisions.
4. Classification will be in accordance with current ATA Rules and based on the shooter's official ATA registered averages and known ability. Please have your average card up to date to ensure proper classification. There will be five classes, five categories and four yardage groups. There will be no class or yardage penalties.
5. Trophies will be awarded in 5 categories Wednesday through Friday to Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior. Trophies will be awarded in 6 categories Saturday and Sunday to Lady, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior. *A special category shooter whose event score qualifies for a special category trophy is not eligible for class or yardage trophies. A special category shooter whose event score does not qualify for a special category trophy is eligible for class or yardage group trophies.* Please check your cashier's sheet to make sure your category as indicated is correct. Only classification errors will be corrected.
6. Ties will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap ties will be shot off if any of the involved shooters has a yardage change. There will be no class advancements for this shoot, however, any shooter's class/score is subject to review. Any remaining ties will be shot off Sunday following the handicap.
7. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap due to missed squads or gun repairs. Make-ups must be completed immediately following the event.
8. Any shooter who has not received monies won during this tournament, agrees that payment in the form of a check will be mailed to the address indicated by ATA records. When mailed, neither 2 Lazy 2, the BACTC or the ASTA will be liable for any checks lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered, or otherwise not received by the shooter. Checks not cashed within 90 days will become void.
9. The consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to shooting in any event, including shoot-offs and practice, is not allowed and will result in disqualification of any scores shot. **The BACTC does not allow alcohol on the premises.**
10. Management reserves the right to change/modify the shoot program at their discretion if deemed necessary
