3. Entries open at 8:00 AM, Singles close at
Noon, Handicap at 2 PM and Doubles at 3 PM.
4. Full orange targets will be thrown.
5. All ties will be shot-off at the end of the day.



7. Sub-Juniors & Juniors may shoot for 1/2 target price provided no options are played.

8. Persons shooting 100 targets only in a 200 bird event are not eligible to play options. Also, shooters withdrawing from an event will not be refunded option money.

9. MMSC will award \$100 to anyone who shoots 100 straight in Doubles or Handicap or 200 straight in Singles.
