To our First annual Spring Fling Silver Shoot

The Staff of the WSRC, The Friends of the WSRC and the Illinois

Department of Natural Resources welcome you to the World Shooting
and Recreational Complex.

### A few Notes:

- 1. All events will be shot on West Line using Skeet Field numbering.
- 2. Clubhouse will open at 8:00 AM each day.
- 3. Practice Traps open at 8:00 AM \$7.50 for 25 targets.
- 4. Ammo availability will be limited. Call Karen at Gipson Quality Firearms for availability (816) 547-4382.
- 5. Options won will be checks and will be mailed after the event.
- 6. Refund Policy: Target money will not be refunded once cashiered. Option money can be refunded until the start of the event at which time it becomes non-refundable.
- 7. All pre-squad positions for all events each day will be held until 30 minutes prior to the first event of the day. After that time, pre-squadded positions not yet cashiered for that day will be cancelled and opened to all shooters.
- 8. Pre-Squad Available February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024, on www.ScoresR.com
- 9. Class Advance for winners on all events.
- 10. Golf Carts & Side by Sides are permitted with a signed usage agreement and a copy of your insurance with CSL of \$500,000.
- 11. Camping is available at Camp.exploremoreil.com/location/285
- 12. A Minimum of 5 Shooters per Class or category is required to award trophy.
- 13. All Trophies will be Silver Bullion ranging from  $\frac{1}{4}$  oz. Rounds to Silver Eagles to 10oz bars.
- 14. The Rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association will govern this shoot.
- 15. Shootoffs will be under the sole direction of the WSRC Trap Manager and may be flipped for winners or reverse run if not shot off.
- 16. Food will be available near the clubhouse or Native Restaurant all weekend.
- 17. ATA Daily Fee \$4.00, ISTA Daily Fee \$3.00
- 18. Cash or Check only for Options
- 19. Credit Cards can be used for targets, fees and dues with 3% additional fee.

### **CLASSIFICATION:**

- 1. Shooters who do not have a combined total of 300 16-yard targets in the current year will be advanced one class or more at the discretion of the classification manager
- 2. Shooters who do not have a combined total of 300 Doubles targets in the current year will be advanced one class or more at the discretion of the classification manager
- 3. Shooters who do not have a total of 300 Handicap targets registered with the ATA in the current target year will be assigned to the 23-yard line or the regular Handicap yardage, whichever is greater.
- 4. Handicap target requirements will be waived for shooters age 70 and over, making them eligible for trophies and monies.
- 5. A Shooter may elect to shoot for targets only for \$28/100
- 6. Sub-Junior will fall into Junior (0-17yo)
- 7. Lady I and Lady II will fall into Lady
- 8. Senior Veteran will fall into Veteran (65yo and up)
