

Hi AIM Coaches & Thank you for helping youth enjoy our great sport.

Our State shoot is only a couple of weeks away. We are expecting around 200 youth this year. Please email me and bring a copy with you of the form “AIM State Championship Team Registration” from the FORMS section in the AIM web site.

Put in your ATA number and your password and you can get to the team builder section. I’m just starting myself so many of you are probably way ahead of me. But if you have questions call (815-295-1194) and we’ll figure it out.

When you classify your teams the Illinois directors will classify the youth by ATA rules. I will have hand written score sheets and classify the youth by the AIM classes found on pages 4 & 5 of the AIM Handbook.

Don’t forget the Tuesday shoot off after the last team finishes shooting. See the program for how the shoot off works. All youth will be in the shoot off!

Wed. morning the singles will be the first event. I’m planning to have the team and Individuals awards by around 3P.M.

The other new item at this years AIM state is “AIM Over-all.” This is an event for individuals this year. This will be for Wed. singles, Handicap, & Doubles. We will have the awards as soon as all of the doubles scores are in Wed. evening. Signup with me and let me know what handicap and doubles squads. There will be awards for champion, runner up, & 3rd place in all categories & classes.

Remember one of the things not mentioned in trapshooting etiquette is shooting in timely manner that is try to have your teams complete their 100 targets in an hour or less. That leaves daylight for everyone.
