**AMATUER TRAP ASSOCIATION CONDUCTS SECOND ANNUAL MASSACHUSETTS AIM STATE YOUTH TRAPSHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP**

BURLINGTON, MA, June 12, 2010 – The Massachusetts AIM State Youth Championship was held on June 12, 2010 at Minuteman Sportsman Club in conjunction with the 2010 99<sup>th</sup> Annual Massachusetts Trapshooting Championships.

On a dark overcast day 37 young athletes competed in four age categories for individual and team medals in the 16 yard 200 target singles event.

In the Collegiate Category, Katie Oertel from Southborough Rod & Gun Club won first place with a 161 and ran her first 25 straight. In the Junior Category, Gus Greaves secured first place with a 194 and ran 100 straight on the back side of the program Cory Monique from Southborough and Tyler Auger from Minuteman Sportsman tied for second place with 192. In third place was Ryan Monique from Southborough with a 185. In the Sub-Junior Category, Tucker Quinlan from Minuteman placed first with a 174. Jack LaBonte from Southborough placed second with a 161. Third place went to Charlie Waters from Maynard Rod & Gun with a 153. In the Pre-Sub Junior Category, Russell Pearson from Southborough finished first with an impressive 187. Hank Garvey, Minuteman Sharpshooters placed second with a 154. Owen Hale and Shepard Greene both shooting for Maynard tied for third.

In the team contest, the junior team of Cory Monique, Ryan Monique, Mark Andrews, Ryan Snow and John Millar from Southborough Rod & Gun Club tied the Junior Team of Tyler Auger, Tucker Quinlan, Nicole Ellis, Nick Rabies and Erik Zani from Minuteman Sportsman Club for the Junior Team champion. Both teams posted a combined 876. Southborough's sub-junior team of Jack LaBonte, Cam Williams, Liam Doherty, Russell Pearson and Tristan Guerin took the Sub-Junior Team Category championship with a combined 777. Mr. William Anzaldi, Vice President of the ATA presented the awards.

The Massachusetts AIM program gratefully acknowledges the outstanding support provided by our state association. The MASS State shoot is a first class venue for the AIM State Championship and one our young athletes enjoy tremendously.
