# NRA / ATA Trap Coach School

Those attending the NRA/ATA Trap Coach School must meet at least **one** of the following prerequisites:

1. Have shot registered trap targets
2. Have shot competitive trap (formal league, club shoot, etc.)
3. Be a current NRA Certified Shotgun Instructor
4. Be a current coach for a youth trap team
5. Show other evidence of experience in trapshooting

The course will run from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM each day. The cost will be \$175 which will include credentials for three years from both ATA and NRA. The class is limited to 20 students.
