General Information

1. Shooting is \$23.00 per 100, except \$20.00 for
the Singles Marathon and the May 8 shoot.

ATA daily fees are \$4.00.

2. Mt. Morris Sportsman's Club reserves the
right to modify or cancel the program as
conditions warrant.

3. Entries open at 8:00 AM, Singles close at
Noon, Handicap at 2 PM and Doubles at 3 PM.

4. Full orange targets will be thrown.

5. All ties will be shot-off at the end of the day.

6. Sub-Juniors & Juniors may shoot for 1/2
target price provided no options are played.

7. Persons shooting 100 targets only in a 200
bird event are not eligible to play options. Also,
shooters withdrawing from an event will not be
refunded option money.

8. MMSC will award \$100 to anyone who shoots
100 straight in Doubles or Handicap or 200
straight in Singles.

9. Food and refreshments available.

10. The club is located on 2887 Swanson Rd, left
Begole Rd. which intersects Rt. 36 just South
of the Mt. Morris village line. Look for our sign
at Rt. 36 and Begole Rd. Motel accommodations
available at the Country Inn & Suites (585-658-
4080) North of Mt. Morris on Rt. 36.

11. Primitive camping only available.

**13. For the May 29 shoot, we will be
shooting 50 birds per trap (2 rounds of 25)
on Singles and you will need to bring 50
shells to the line to help speed up the event.**
