Highlights

John Ulsher started out the event the best of all the 18 entries. Ulsher shot the first 50 with a score of 50. Ulsher's first lost target came on the 58th clay. Ulsher lost his 74th and 77th targets to finish tied for the second best score, tying Ben Olsen.

Brad Bowman shot 25 by 25 on his second and fourth traps. Bowman missed his 20th and 52nd targets for the event's top score of 98.

Ben Olsen and Gerald Atol each shot lone 25 straights and the last of the shooters to claim a straight in their scores. Atol opened with a straight and Olsen shot the third trap straight. Olsen and Atol's scores made them part of the top four scores and three or more targets ahead of the rest of the group of shooters.

Highlights

Thomas Faulkenberry started and finished the best of all the shooters in the event. Faulkenberry missed his 19th target for an opening 24 of 25 score. Faulkenberry's remaining losses were at his 26th, 48th, and 54th targets. Faulkenberry shot all 25 on his

final trap to post the only 25 straight in the event as part of a 46 target finishing run of hit targets. Faulkenberry's event win earned him the event Champion title and an automatic half-yard punch on his card.

Dave Kaiser posted the only other 90+ score in the event with his finishing score of 91. Kaiser opening score of 23 on the first trap was better with a 24 on his third trap.

Jim McCormick, John Zajchowski, Gerald Atol and Mike Wascom were able to shoot 80-something scores in the gray, snowing conditions. The rest of the field succumbed to conditions posting scores in the 70s or below.
