Jeff Pokorny was the only other one to shoot two 25 straights, at his fourth and fifth traps. Pokorny's scores gave him the only 50 straight in the event. Pokorny never lost more than two targets on his other six fields.

John Farner posted the second best score in the event with a single 25 straight and five other fields where he missed only one target.

Dennis Geary, Brad Bowman, and Dave Cross were the only other shooters to have one 25 straight trap.
